Prior to pathology training, Dr. Jiang completed Dermatology residency and a masters program in Immunology in China.

As the pathology team is recruited and on-boarded, we continue to invest in the surgical pathology capabilities at CPL. We have validated a large menu of antibodies for immunohistochemistry studies, offer chromogenic and fluorescence in-situ hybridization studies and, with our Sonic Reference Laboratory partner, have somatic mutation and microsatellite instability testing available in Austin. With our fellow Sonic laboratories, ProPath in Dallas and LMC in Las Vegas, the antibody libraries are exhaustive and the experience and expertise in PD-L1 and other prognostic or companion markers is among the largest in the country. In cytopathology, we have invested in new PCR platforms for scalability, productivity, throughput and exceptional turnaround time for the ancillary testing that accompanies the more than 1600 Paps tests that we serve to the Women's Health program every day.

We are streamlining laboratory services that support the triple aim of better patient experience, better health of populations and a sustainable cost. We embrace our obligation to collaborate with the medical community to continuously improve our services and the health of our communities.
